In these Units candidates will develop skills in solo instrumental or vocal performance to an advanced level. They will rehearse a varied programme of music, develop a broad knowledge of their chosen instrument/voice and its repertoire, and present a musical performance.

This Unit is designed to fit with the candidate's experience of performing. It is available as a free-standing Unit, which may be studied as part of a general education, as a leisure interest, or for vocational reasons.

The Performing Music on One Instrument or Voice Units progress from SCQF level 3 to SCQF level 7.
