Course Content

Based on a simple creative process, the qualification has 5 broad learning outcomes which are clearly mapped to the Creative Playlists. This emphasises the process rather than the product, highlighting the importance of the learners' journey and encouraging them to reflect on the strategies they have used to think creatively.

Throughout the course pupils will create a portfolio of work which can showcase their creative journey through their preferred choice of media i.e. Sketching, Desktop Publishing, Photography, Film & Video, Music, Fashion & Textiles.

Skills Developed

The aims of the Course are to develop:

- skills in researching and analysing creative design briefs
- skills in planning and evaluation

No Exam Portfolio (4 Projects externally assessed). Passing the full course equates to one level 6 qualification (24 SCQF credit points)
