Pupils should pick **ONE TRIP ONLY**. A nominal £5 deposit is required via ParentPay to register interest a trip even if a trip is free\*. Payments will open Tuesday 5 November and close Monday 18 November.

Pupils who are already taking part in the Watersports trip **should not** select another trip as part of the May Experience. This trip had to be advertised earlier than the others due to the higher cost and the longer timescale required when organising a trip abroad.

If a trip becomes over-subscribed, a random draw will take place and unsuccessful pupils will be refunded and asked to select another trip.

**\*NB** Where an activity is marked as free, the £5 deposit should still be paid to register interest but will be refunded shortly after payments close on Monday 18 November 2020.

Fishing at Kinross Fishery	<p>Fancy a fishing adventure with the chance of catching double figure Rainbow, Brown and Blue trout? Maybe you have been fishing before; maybe this will be your first time, whatever it is, this is sure to be a memorable experience for you.</p> <p>Pupils will have the opportunity to do either fly fishing or bait fishing at Kinross Fishery. The event will be limited to a maximum of 15 pupils.
