- **Q1:** The 2022 Standards and Qualities Report states "In the Broad General Education, less than half of young people could identify their progress with learning and next steps".
- Q1.1 What was the actual percentage who could identify their progress?
- Q1.2 When this gap was identified by the school, what immediate steps were taken by the Senior management team to rectify the situation?
- Q1.3 How was this communicated to both pupils and parents at that time?

#### **Q2: Report Cards**

- Q2.1 What is the reason behind issuing report cards (S4) so close (Friday before) the prelims when they contain action plans that can not be actions ahead of the prelims?
- Q2.2 There are many subjects that the Support Dept cover but why is there rarely any written feedback within the Tracking Report?
- Q2.3 Why are some subjects taken by ASN students not documented within the tracking report or listed within the Parents Evening booking system?

### **Q3: School Access**

- Q3.1 In relation to kids standing outside during heavy rain. According to the school website, doors only open at 8:40am and close at 8:45am. What is the reason for this? In winter there needs to be more leeway as parents will sometimes need to drop off kids on their way to work etc. The school buses can arrive much earlier than this too.
- Q3.2 When children who go outside for lunch are not able to get back into the building until the bell. Can the rationale please be explained, and what if the weather changes or they need the toilet?

## **Q4: Parents Evening:**

Q4.1 When will Parents know when the S1 and S2 parents evening will be? Can we ensure that there is sufficient time given to Parents and Carers to allow child care to be arranged for these important touch points with teachers.

Q4.2 Why does every child not have a slot for parents' night?

Q4.3 With the absence of Mr Baird, why can't the maths teacher who is taking my young person's S1 class for two days of the week meet with the parents at parent contact?

#### **Q5: Recruitment:**

Q5.1 What is the SLTs contingency plan if they fail to recruit into the maths department's the 12 month temporary post which is currently advertised?

Q5.2 Is there sufficient budget to obtain ad hoc supply cover?

Q5.3 What is the current number of vacancies that KHS currently has and is this higher or lower than usual?
