# Inspection messages: Learning and teaching




- Staff work diligently to ensure a calm, safe, and respectful culture for learning. Almost all young people engage well in their learning and are highly motivated to succeed.


- \* Young people are building capacity as effective contributors (parliament, committees, ambassadors)
